

Non-Directory Information (Never Share)

School officials with a "legitimate educational interest" (for example,

- Social Security Number
- Student ID Number
- Grades/Exam Scores
- Grade Point Average (GPA)
- Test Scores (SAT, GRE, etc.)
- Class Schedule
- Race/Ethnicity
- Citizenship/Nationality
- Gender
- Religious Affiliation

- an academic advisor who needs to review what courses a student has completed in order to give advice).
- School to which a student is transferring.
- Organizations conducting certain studies for or on behalf of the school.
- Accrediting organizations.
- Appropriate officials in health and safety emergencies.
- Juvenile justice system authorities.

Definitions	
Personally Identifiable Information (PII)	PII is the student's (or family member's) name, address, personal identifier, and personal characteristics or other information that would make the student's identity easily traceable.
Education Records	An education record is any record that is:
	Directly related to a student; and
	 Maintained by an educational agency or institution, or by a party acting for the agency or institution.
School Official	A "school official" includes a teacher, school principal, president, chancellor, board member, trustee, registrar, counselor, admissions officer, attorney, accountant, human resources professional, information systems specialist, and support or clerical personnel.
Prior Written Consent	Need the consent of a student in writing before release a record or talk about its contents.
Legitimate Educational Interest	A school official has a "legitimate educational interest" if the official needs to review an education record in order to fulfill his or her professional responsibilities.
Directory Information	FERPA identifies certain categories of information as "directory information," which the University may release without student permission.
Eligible Student	Eligible student means a student who has reached 18 years of age or is attending an institution of postsecondary education.
Disclosure	Disclosure means to permit access to or the release, transfer, or other communication of PII contained in Education Records to any party, by any means, including oral, written, or electronic means.
Employment Records	Records relating to an individual who is employed by the University not as a result of his or her status as a student are excluded.
Computer Security	Computer Security ensures the Confidentiality, Integrity and Availability of data-confidentiality of student records, tests, financial information; grades of research data; and availability of resource like email or online databases when they are needed.
Law Enforcement Unit	A "law enforcement unit" means any individual, office, department, division, or other component of a school, such as a unit of commissioned police officers or noncommissioned security guards, that is officially authorized or designated by that school.
